Ancient Egypt

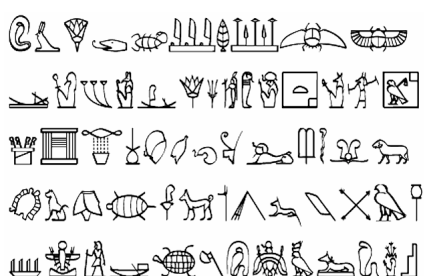
