As part of our recent fundraising drive, Prospect Vale joined a local Tesco community project to raise money for our Sensory Garden. Every time people shopped in Tesco stores across Heald Green and Stockport, they could place a token in one of three schools' boxes. The school with the most tokens after several weeks would win £1,500.

But then came some dramatic news... On Thursday, we were told that a special Golden Token event would take place on Saturday at 12pm. A bag of 100 tokens would be used, and whichever school received the Golden Token would secure a £5,000 prize for their project.

The excitement was huge – and so was the tension! We were sent to the wrong Tesco at first and had to race across Stockport to make it to the right store in time. Mr Redfearn and his two children tried their luck but pulled out only blue tokens. Miss Jones also had a go – still no gold!

Meanwhile, members of the public were also taking turns, quickly dropping tokens into one of the school containers (sometimes without even noticing which school they'd chosen!). An official adjudicator kept a close eye on the process to ensure fairness.

With just 20 tokens left, things were looking desperate. And then – in the final moments – Miss Cron's daughter stepped up and pulled out the GOLDEN TOKEN! The crowd erupted, golden confetti rained down from the ceiling, and Prospect Vale had done it!
