Following our recent updates about the transition of our after-school provision, we're pleased to confirm that when we return after the half-term break, our in-house wraparound care will begin!

As shared previously, school will be running the provision directly for the remainder of the term to ensure a smooth and seamless service for all families, ahead of School of Play taking over in January.

Key Details and How to Book

Bookings for after-school club (starting Monday 3rd November) are now open via ParentPay, using the same system as our Breakfast Club. Please note that places are limited to 20 per session.

The club will be managed by Miss Jones (who also leads our breakfast club) and will run every evening until 6:00 PM. The cost remains £10.00 per session, and children will enjoy a range of supervised activities and a nutritious snack each day.
