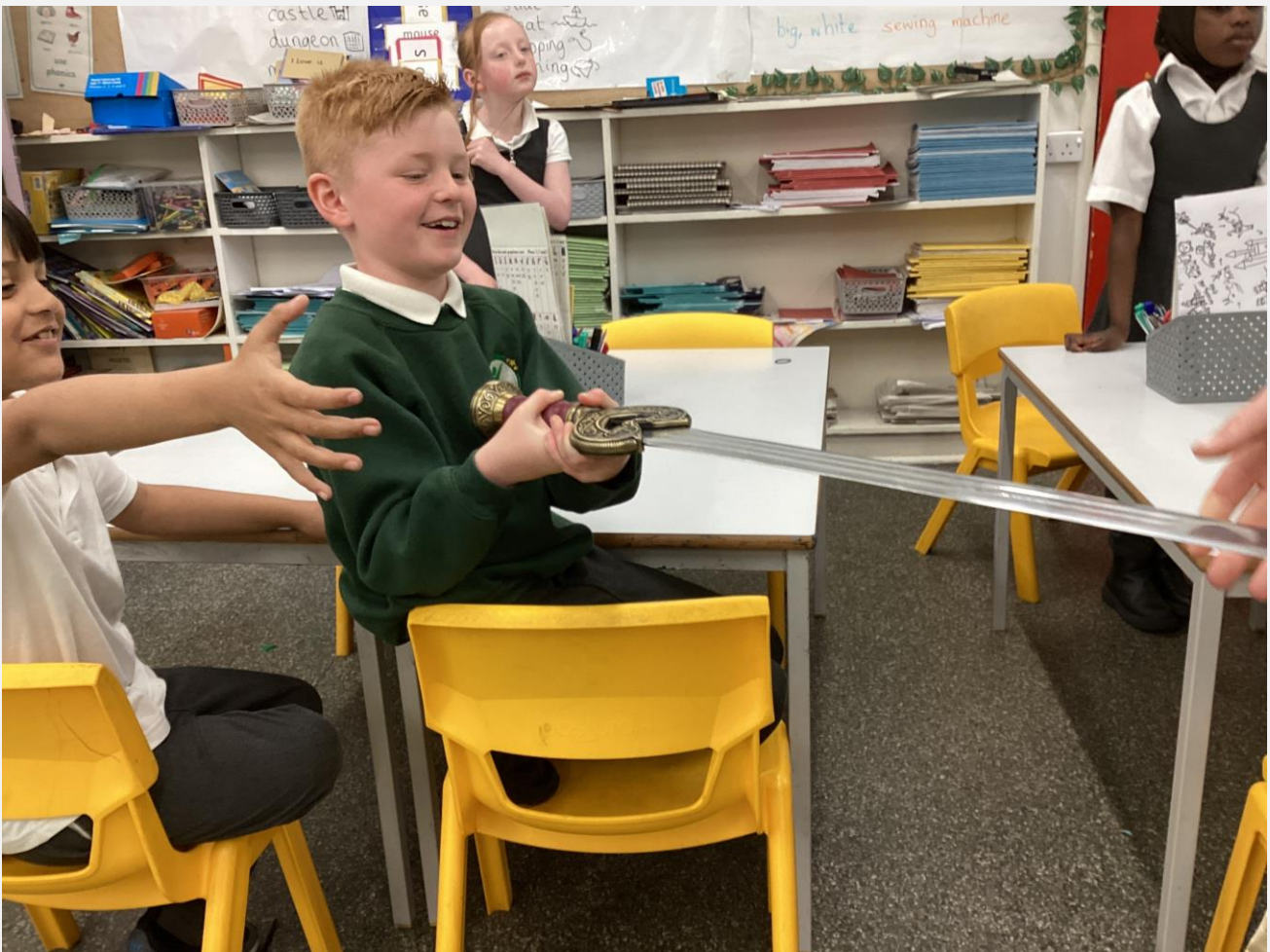
Not only did they have a truly wonderful time, but they also represented the school superbly. Their behaviour and enthusiasm were a credit to us all—well done, Reception!
