Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Talk about caring for animals and looking after the world God made.
- Invite a vet/visitor into school to talk about caring for animals or visit a local pet shop.
- Develop an understanding of caring for others and their property.
- Developing confidence to resolve disagreements with other children in an age-appropriate way.

Literacy:

- Explore a number of stories, rhymes and poems linked to animals.
- Develop writing for a range of purposes.
- Apply phonic knowledge within writing to create CVC words/short captions.
- Develop an understanding of how to read simple captions and sentences using 'Fred- Talk'.
- Continue to take part in daily phonics sessions.
- Develop role play linked to familiar texts liked to pets.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- Create role play linked to the story of Chinese New Year.
- Use materials to create animal masks and use techniques to paint/create different animals.
- Develop a block play ark and invite the children to count in twos as they 'jump on' in order to retell the story Noah's Ark.
- Create opportunities to encourage mark making/ writing skills.
- Create a class Chinese Dragon








Understanding the World:
