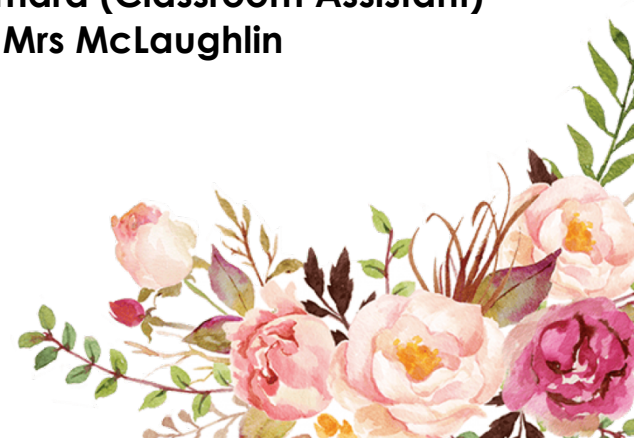

Our topic in the Spring term will loosely be based upon Winter and then animals we keep as pets. We are excited to see where our learning leads us during the Spring Term. Mathematics:

Recognise and count numerals to 10 and beyond. • Say one more or one less than a given number • Use language to compare the size, weight and height of objects. • Name and describe simple 2D shapes. • Begin to use the language of 'adding and taking away with number sentences.'

Literacy:

Explore a number of stories, rhymes and poems linked to animals. • Develop writing for a range of purposes. • Apply phonic knowledge within writing to create CVC words/short captions. • Develop an understanding of how to read simple captions and sentences using 'Fred Talk'. • Continue to take part in daily phonics sessions. • Develop role play linked to familiar texts linked to pets.

Communication and Language:

- understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important
- learn new vocabulary
- use new vocabulary throughout the day

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Talk about caring for animals and looking after the world God made.
- Invite a vet/visitor into school to talk about caring for animals
- Develop an understanding of caring for others and their property.
- Developing confidence to resolve disagreements with other children in an age-appropriate way.
- Develop the understanding of looking after individual's wants, needs and desires.

Physical Development:

- Developing fine motor control to hold tools for writing.
- Develop secure pencil grip to form letters correctly.
- Complete 'self-help' skills independently.
- Show a preference for a dominant hand

Understanding the World:

- Name different animals who entered the ark.
- Talk about caring for Pets and looking after the,
- Explore the story 'Noah's Ark'
- Explore Chinese New Year and different celebrations.
