

Year 4 Spellings – 3rd October 2025

Key spelling rule: If the last syllable of a word is stressed and ends with one consonant letter which has just one vowel letter before it, the final consonant letter is doubled before -ed or -ing e.g. admitting. The consonant letter is not doubled if the last syllable is unstressed e.g. marketing.
