We can't believe this is the last half term before Summer and the children move to Year 1. We will be working really hard right up to when we finish in July, and so it's important to continue practicing reading, writing and maths skills.

Literacy

The text for this half term is 'Supertato'. Most children are familiar with the story, and we begin by the evil peas coming into our classroom. Throughout the topic, children will be writing about their own super powers, and describing different super hero characters. We will be pushing the children daily with their letter formation and hold a sentence activities.

Children will be expected to write simple captions and sentences each day, and so we would appreciate this practice to continue at home.

Religious Education

The final branch of our RE teaching is Dialogue and Encounter, where we will learn about being good friends, and the friends of Jesus, St Peter and St Paul. We will look at the stories shared in Mass, alongside exploring what it is like to be a good neighbour and member of a family.

Mathematics

This half term we will introduce Rekenreks to the children, how we use them and how the beads should look before we start. We move onto recapping everything we have learnt this year, ensuring we try to tackle any misconceptions that may still be there and correcting them. Children will be asked to complete lots of practical activities and taking our learning outside to enjoy learning in our environment.

Physical Development

Our PE lessons this half term will see the children practice different striking and fielding games, putting into place all the skills we have learnt this year. We will be outdoors making use of our space, hitting balls, trying to catch and throw, and work together as a team.

Understanding the world

We will think about our friends and families and how to keep safe. Our topic will extend to think about real life superheroes and the people that work hard to help us each day.

We will be looking at superheroes throughout our final half term, thinking about our behaviour and showing the school our super powers. We will also think carefully about a super hero diet, and what food choices we can make to be healthy and strong.

Expressive arts and design

Children will work to create their own healthy snacks, fruit and smoothies. We will also be designing our own super hero suits and capes, along with comic strips, acting out and undertaking roles within play.
