brussel sprouts

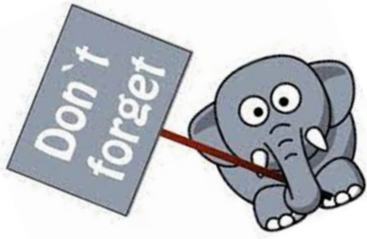
