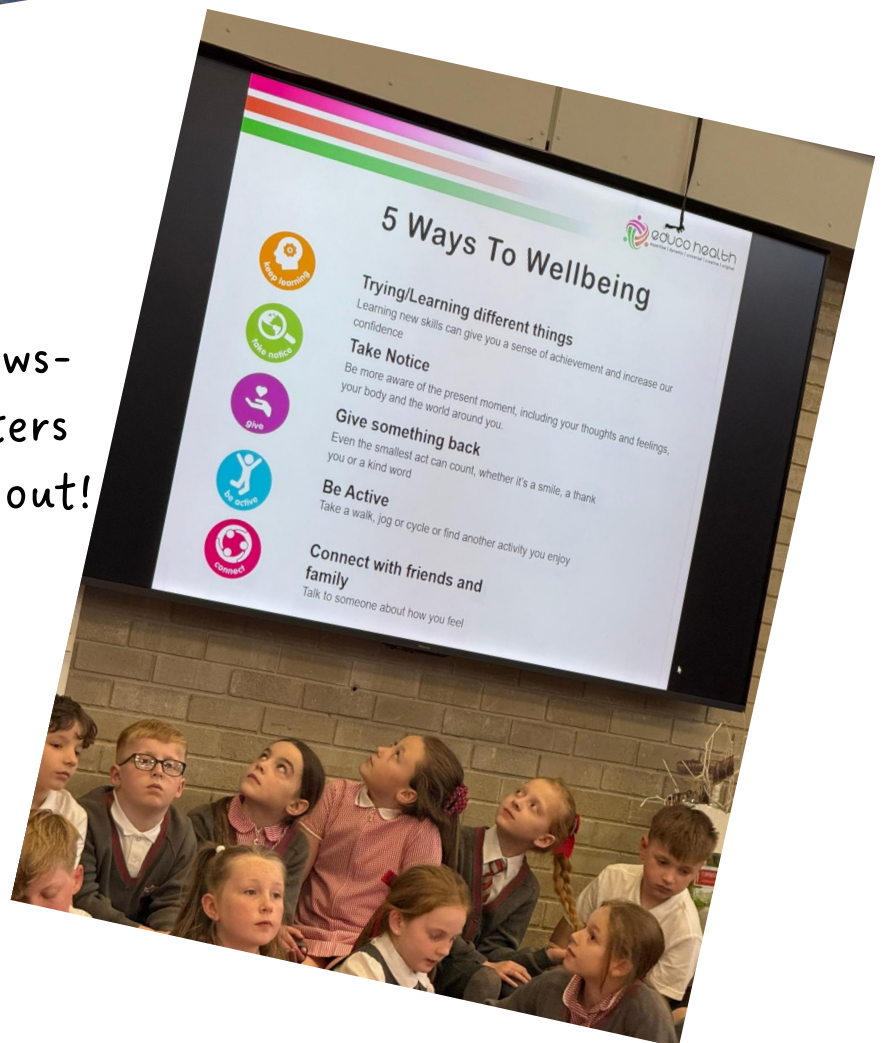

Punctuality Reminder

We have noticed that a number of children have been arriving late to school recently, and this is a concern that has been getting worse. Being on time is essential for children's learning, wellbeing, and sense of routine. Arriving promptly helps pupils settle into the day calmly and ensures they do not miss important teaching time.

Our school start times are as follows:

- **8:40am** - Gates open
- **8:45am** - Bell rings and children line up
- 8:50am** - Children should be in class and registration is taken

Please note:

- Any pupil arriving after these times will be marked as **late**.

Pupils arriving after **9:05am** (when registration closes) will be marked as **late after registration**, which is recorded as an **unauthorised absence for the session**.
