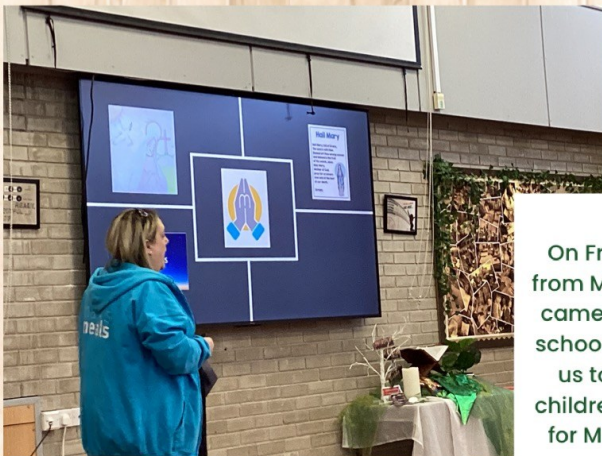

Pupils arriving after **9:05am** (when registration closes) will be marked as **late after registration**, which is recorded as an **unauthorised absence for the session**.
