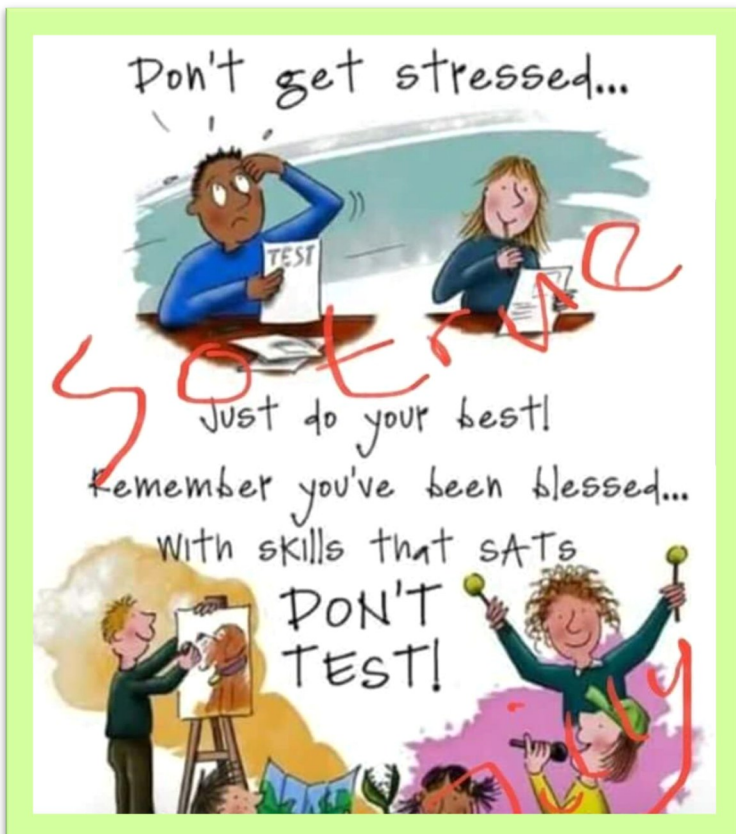
GOOD LUCK

Protect them from worry, stress and panic; give them a calm mind, confidence and energy.

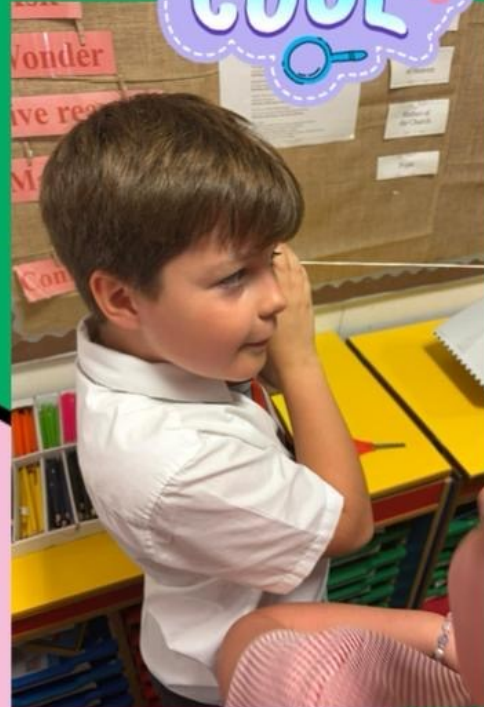
May they give their best then knowing it's in your hands. Amen

SCIENCE is COOL



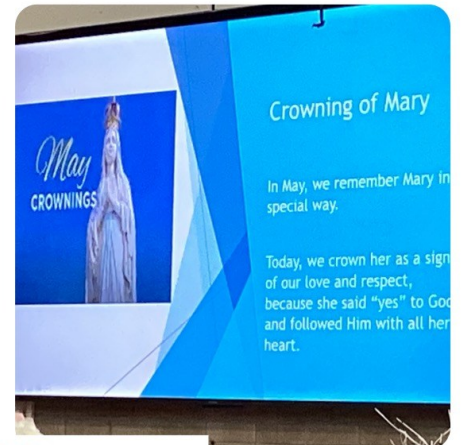
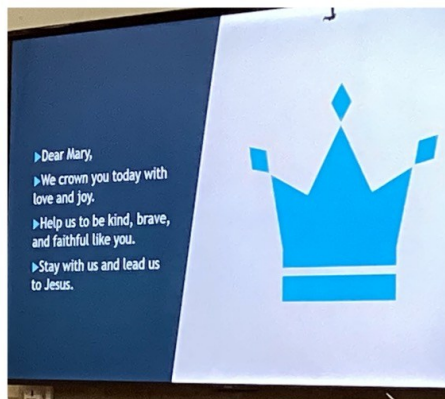
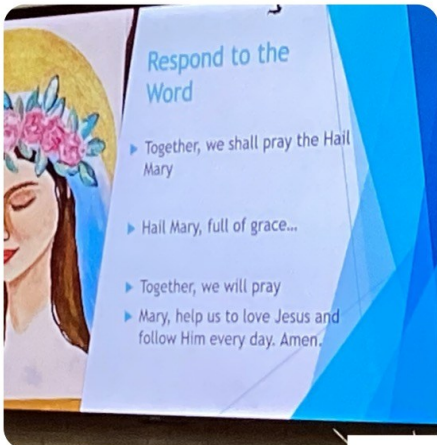
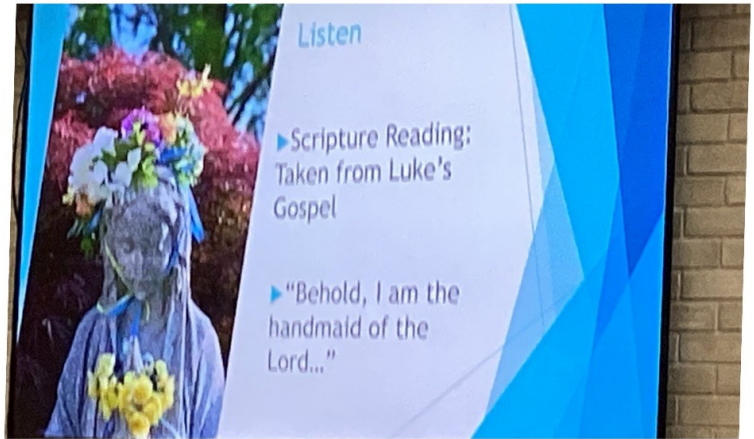
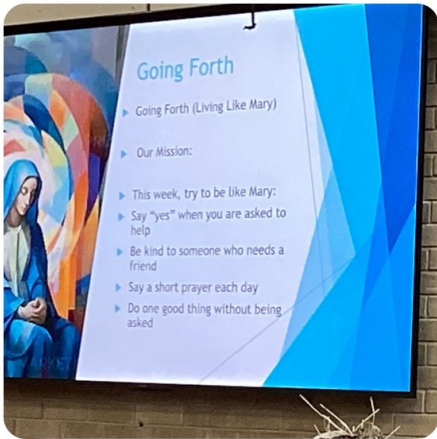
In Year 4 Science, we explored how sound travels by making string telephones using cups and string. The children investigated how vibrations travel and enjoyed testing how well their telephones worked!

Year 2

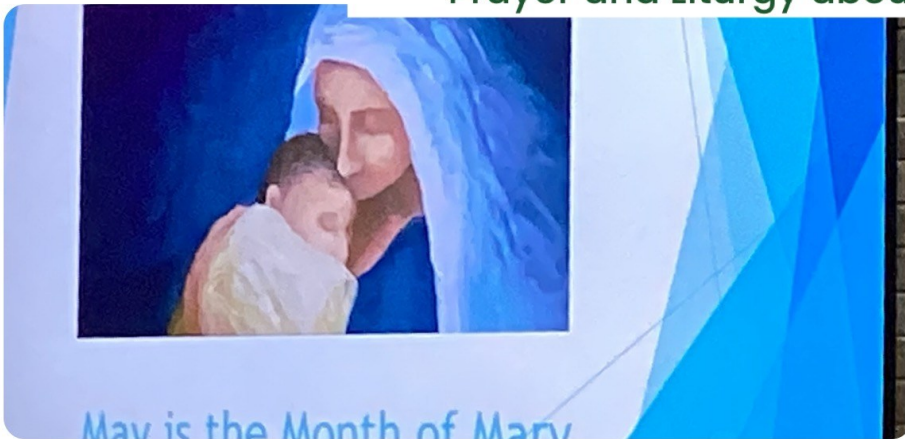
