This week all of Year 6 received the Superstar Award for trying their best during their SATs tests.

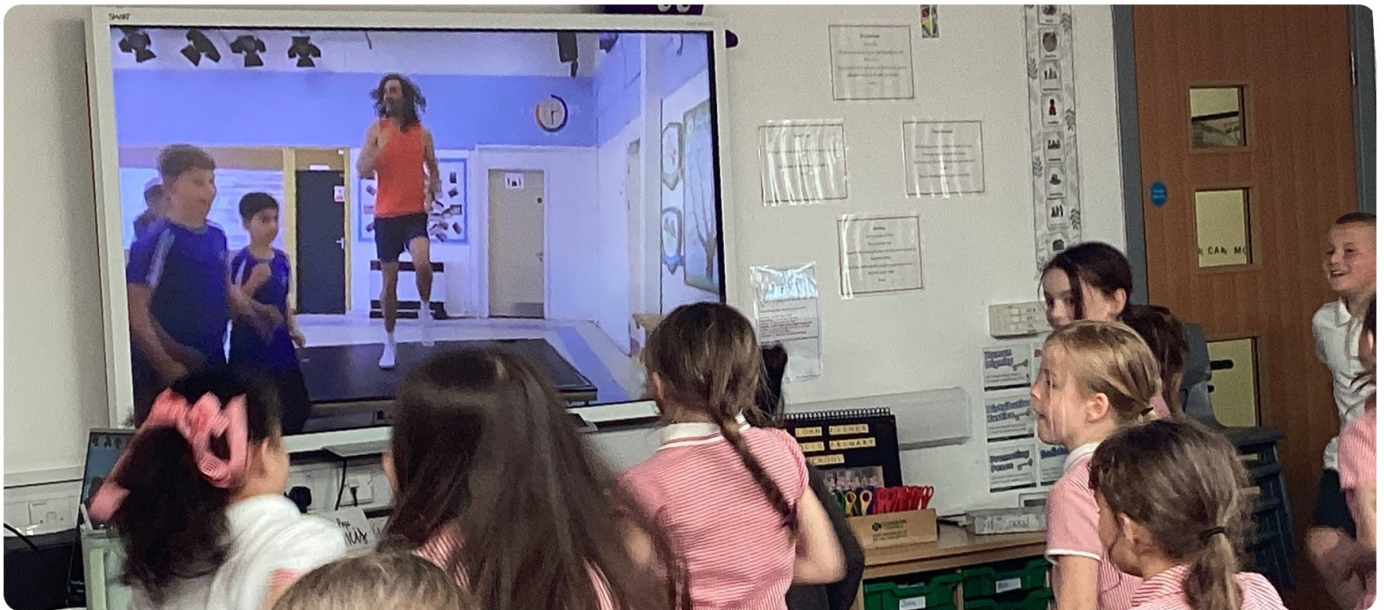


To celebrate the end of their exams, Year 6 took a well deserved trip to the park.

Year 3 joined in with "The Big School Workout" hosted by Joe Wicks as part of Mental Health Awareness Week.

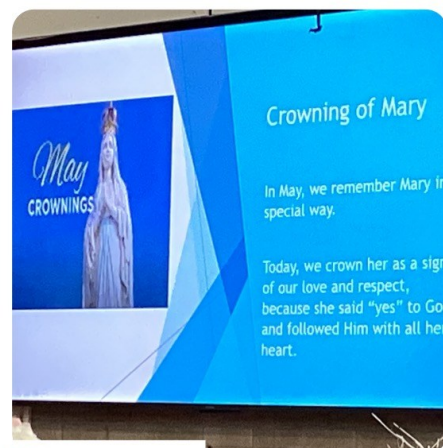
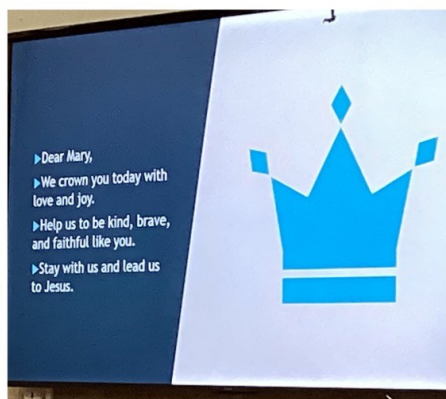
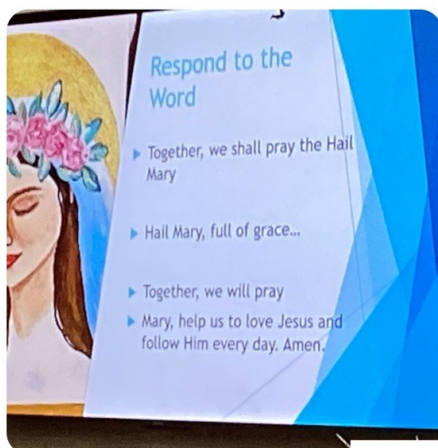
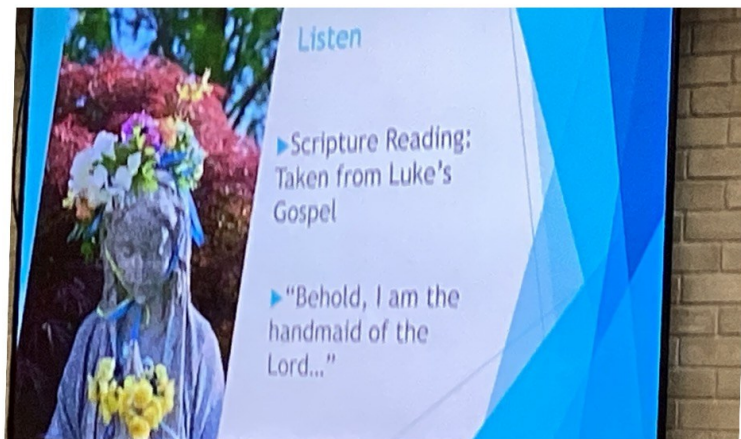
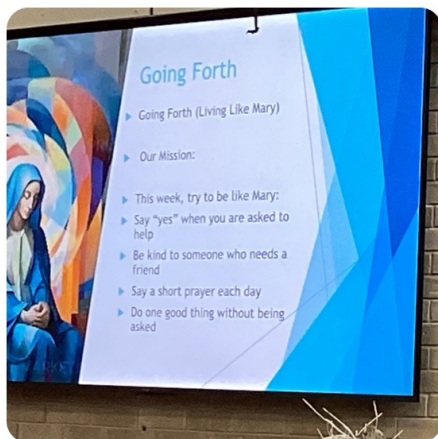

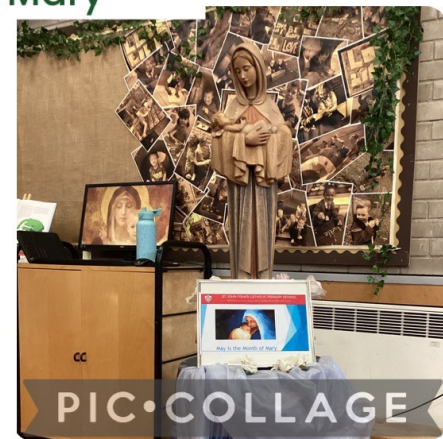
Missing Cat

One of our children's cat has gone missing. He is very much loved and missed. Please look out for him and if found please contact 07568 378851 .





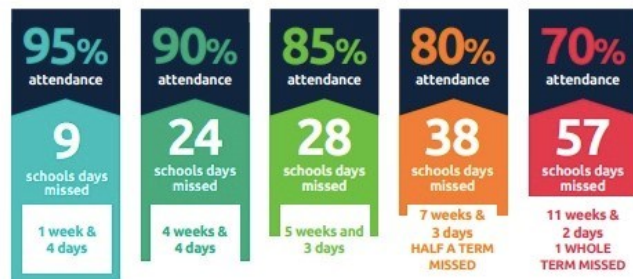
