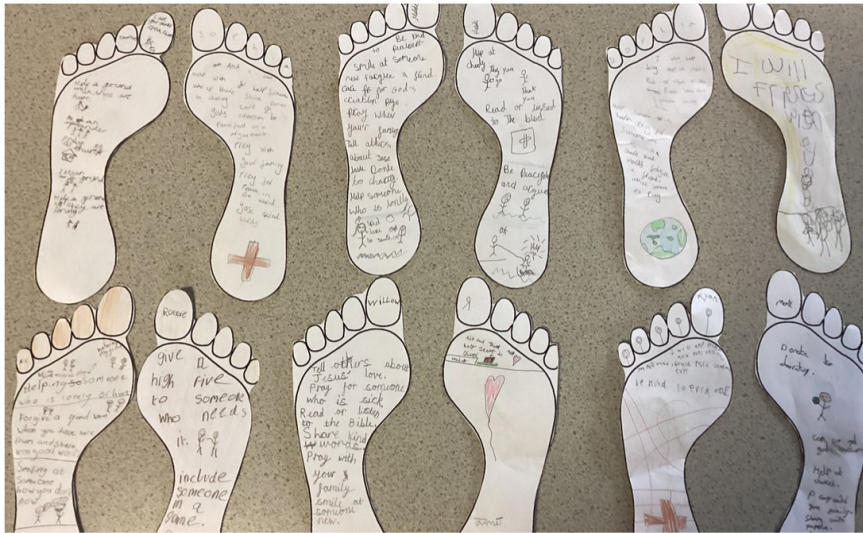

Sports Day was a great success, the rain held off and the children had lots of fun.

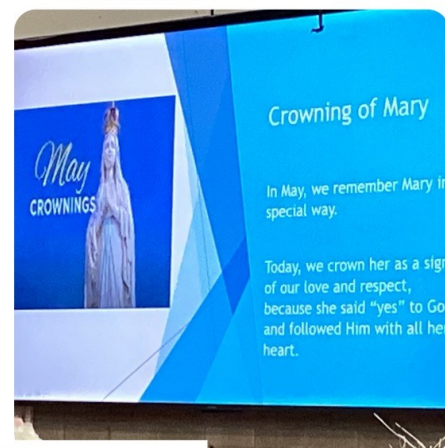
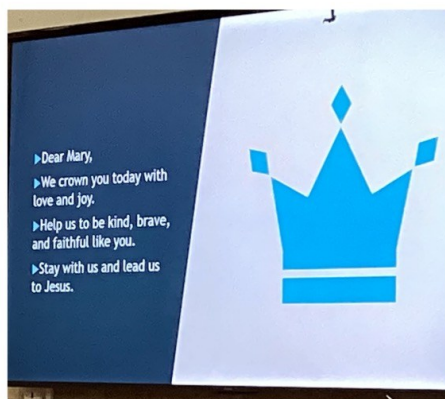
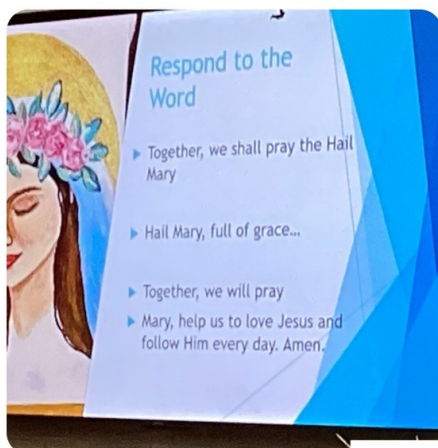
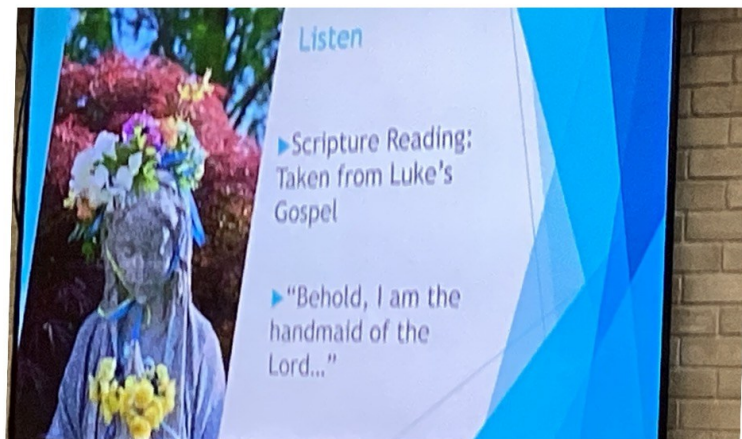
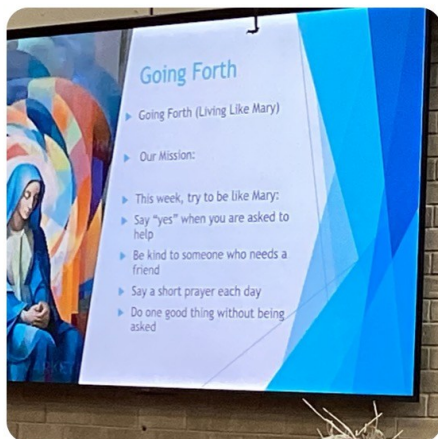

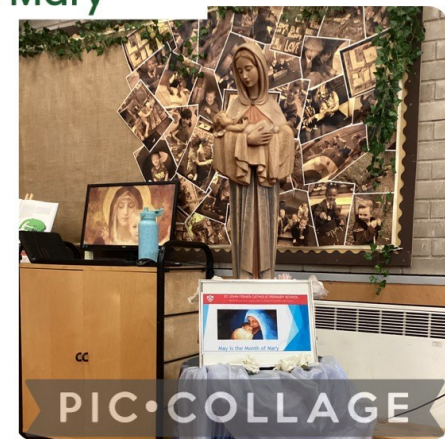


In today's RE lesson year 3 talked about how to be disciples and spread the good news about Jesus we wrote on footprints and placed them all around the school.
