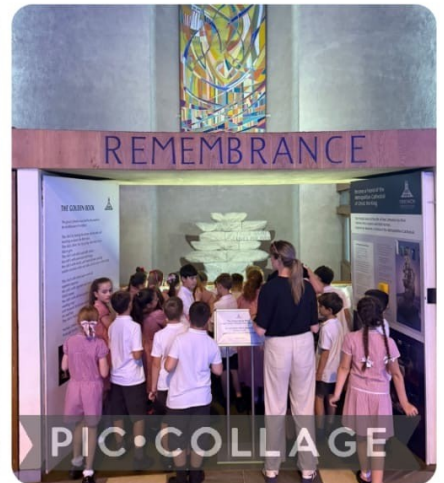
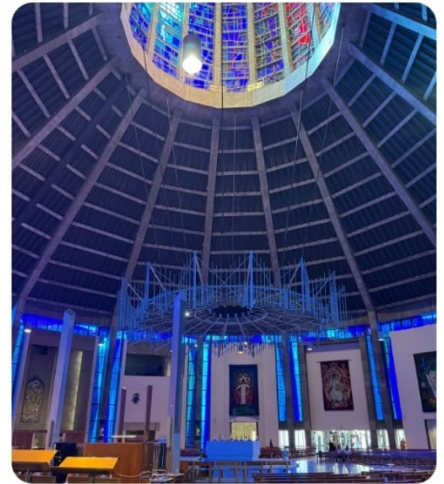

Sunglasses and/or a hat (optional) Sunglasses and hats will also be available to purchase on the day, along with a selection of refreshments.

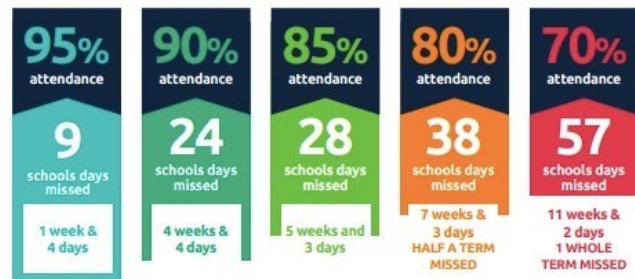
This is set to be a fantastic, fun-filled event for all involved, and we can't wait to see everyone there!
