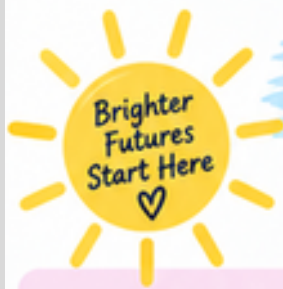

As we begin a new academic year, we would like to take this opportunity to remind all families about the importance of **regular attendance and good punctuality**.

Every day in school matters. Being in school regularly gives children the best opportunity to learn, make progress, build friendships and feel part of our school community. Arriving on time is equally important, as even a few minutes late can mean missing important learning, morning routines and the chance to start the day calmly and confidently.

Our Morning Timings



8.40am

School gates open



8.45am

The bell rings and the children line up



8.50am

Children are in class and the register is taken

Arriving late

Children arriving after **8.50am** will be recorded as **late**.

After 9.05am

A child arriving after **9.05am** will be recorded as late **after** registration has closed – this is classed as an **unauthorised absence** for the **whole session**.



Working together to support good attendance

We understand that sometimes families experience difficulties which can make getting to school regularly or on time challenging. If there is anything affecting your child's attendance or punctuality, **please come and talk to us**. We would much rather work with you to identify what support might help than allow a problem to continue.

Our attendance procedure

Where lateness or absence becomes a regular concern, the following will take place:

- 1** The class teacher will have a conversation with parents to discuss reasons for lateness/absence and, if appropriate, what support strategies can be put in place.
- 2** The Pastoral Lead will contact parents informally for discussion about continued absence/lateness.
- 3** Formal written letter from the Head Teacher.
- 4** Where school action fails to bring an improvement, the matter will be discussed with the Education Welfare Service and consideration given to issuing a Penalty Notice.

- A paper copy of the preference form can also be requested from schooladmissions@halton.gov.uk
- All online applicants will receive their offer of a school place electronically on the 16th April 2027
- Offer letters will be posted on the 16th April 2027 to applicants who submitted a paper preference form
- Don't leave it too late – you are likely to miss out on the school place you want if you apply late. **Deadline is 15th Jan 2027**

Closing date for Primary School Applications:
15th January 2027

- All online applicants will receive their offer of a school place electronically on the 1st March 2027
- Offer letters will be posted on 1st March 2027 to applicants who submitted a paper preference form
- Don't leave it too late – you are likely to miss out on the school place you want if you apply late. **Deadline is 31st October 2026**

Closing date for Secondary School Applications:
