HELPING AT HOME

Reading

Spelling

Your child will be set spellings to learn each week and will be tested the following week. Please ensure that your child learns these. Practice with them and test them so they know how many they know before their spelling test. Year 3 will be given spelling on a Friday and tested on the following **FRIDAY.**
