If your child is absent from school for

Transition

During the summer term we will be
supporting children as some prepare
to transition to a new room at nursery
or to a primary school. Where

telephone and we'll be happy to chat.

Note: Children will usually transition
from 2s to F1 the term after they are
3 years old. Their session times will
remain the same e.g. mornings or
afternoons.

30-hour funding please request this
as soon as possible as places can

ALL CHILDREN AGED 3-4 YEARS OLD ARE ELIGIBLE FOR UP TO 15 HOURS OF FUNDED EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE PER WEEK (BEGINNING THE TERM FOLLOWING THEIR 3RD BIRTHDAY).

IF YOU ARE WORKING YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE UP TO 30 HOURS.
