Children who are due to start at Somerville Primary School in September 2026, should call at the nursery between 8.30-9.10 am so that your child can have their photo taken (with or without any siblings). You can then head up to school for the transition event.

The photographer will only be here in the morning so we welcome you to call in with any children who attend afternoon sessions anytime up until 10.30 am – please queue at the side gate.

Important: If you are attending with your child outside of their normal session and / or with younger children, please note that you are responsible for your child /children whilst they are on the school site.

(We have a supply of legionnaire style hats which children can use if needed) Please be assured that children have access to drinking water throughout their sessions so do not need to bring a water bottle into school..

3-4 YEAR OLDS

ALL CHILDREN AGED 3-4 YEARS OLD ARE ELIGIBLE FOR UP TO 15 HOURS OF FUNDED EARLY EDUCATION AND CHILDCARE PER WEEK (BEGINNING THE TERM FOLLOWING THEIR 3RD BIRTHDAY).

IF YOU ARE WORKING YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE UP TO 30 HOURS.
