Meeting your child

- Over the next few weeks Miss Gill our current Reception teacher will visit your child at Nursery.
- If your child does not attend a nursery please do come and speak to us tonight to make a separate appointment.
- Nursery visits and information will give us a good overview of what stage of development your child is currently working at.
- Please let us know if you would like a chance to discuss your child's development prior to September.



Working together



- We encourage the children to be as independent as possible. For example putting on their own coat and zipping it up, toileting skills and following instructions.
- Sharing books regularly and talking together about what is on each page. This develops language and reading skills.
- ► I have added a page in your welcome packs explaining how you can help your child be Reception ready over the summer.

September Start Date

Your child's first day start date will be Thursday 4th September 9:00am – 12:00pm

Any siblings of new starters can arrive slightly later on that morning to share the experience.

You will pick your child up from the side gate at 12:00.

We will continue a half day on 5th September 9:00am-12:00pm then on 8th September your child will start school full time.





Love of Reading and stories

Reading is a fundamental life skill

- It opens the imagination
- It helps build communication skills
- It can improve mental health and well being

In Reception reading is taught through a range of strategies with a strong emphasis on phonics.





Phonics

- ► Reading is taught through a structured phonics programme called 'Little Wandle' with a daily lesson.
- ► We learn letter **sounds/ phonemes** which we can **blend** together in order to read a word. **E.g c-a-t**.
- Encourage your child to make clear sounds as it will make it easier to hear the word that is being blended.







