Ideas for learning to read words

Use a dice and counters and use the words like a board game. If you land on it you have to read it.

Photocopy the words and play as snap or pairs, reading each word as you turn it over.

Hide the words around the room. As you find them you have to read them out loud.

Put the cut up words into a pot and mix them up. Take it in turns to pull a word out and read it. It has to go back in the pot if you can't.

Put the word mat in a prominent position like the front of the fridge. Every time your child passes it they have to read a line. Build up to reading the whole mat as fast as you can.

Eventually focus on just the words you don't know.

IF YOUR CHILD CAN READ ALL THE WORDS PLEASE PRACTISE SPELLING THEM.
