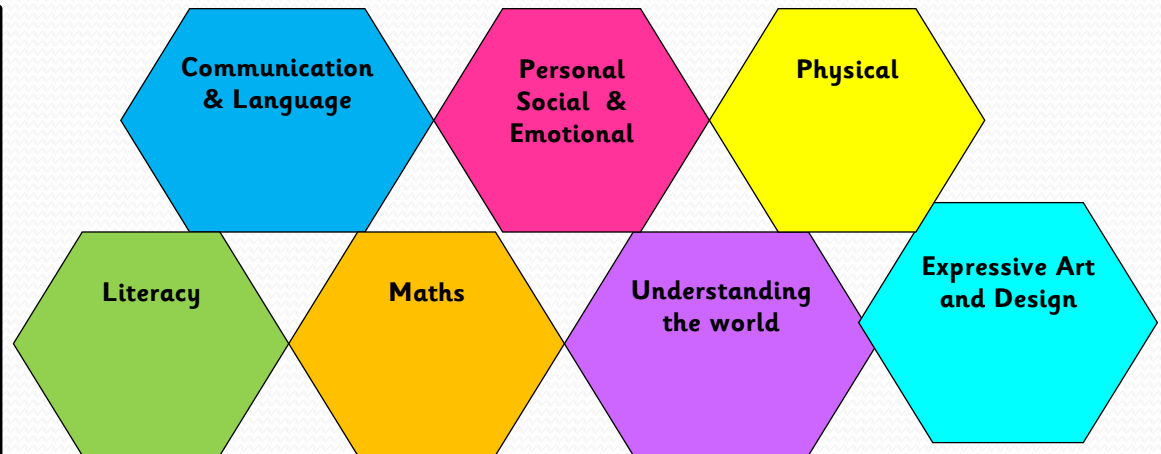
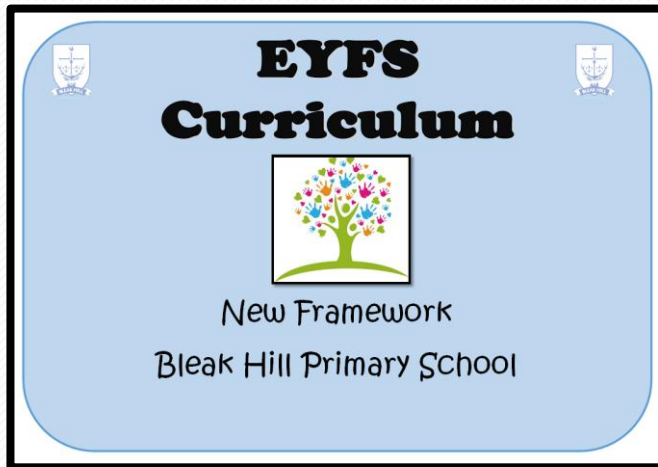

In addition, the '**Characteristics of Effective Learning**' underpin learning and development across all areas and support the child to remain an effective and motivated learner.

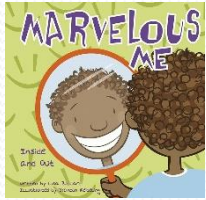

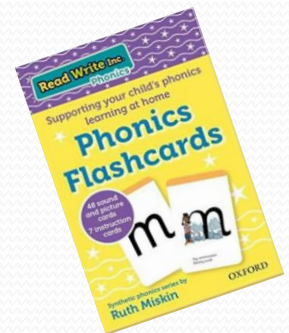
