Message from Mr Dagnall

This week has been a busy and exciting one here at Bleak Hill Primary School, with a number of significant events taking place across the school community.

Science week has provided our children with a wealth of engaging learning opportunities. Monday saw the celebration of Super Scientist Day, which was followed by Year 5 receiving specialist lessons from Professor Copple and his colleague on Tuesday and Wednesday. These sessions allowed our children to benefit from expert knowledge and hands-on experience in scientific exploration. Miss Blacker hosted a Science fair for Key Stage 2 children yesterday, which showcased the enthusiasm and curiosity our children have demonstrated throughout the week. Thursday 27th March 2026 - Doors Open 5.45pm, Eyes Down 6.00pm


