## Message from Mr Dagnall

It has been a wonderful week at Bleak Hill Primary School, with the sun shining and plenty of positive activity across the school. I have taken the opportunity to visit every class this week to speak with the children about the importance of respect. These conversations have reinforced our shared values and highlighted the excellent behaviour and attitudes demonstrated by our children on a daily basis.

This week has been particularly successful in terms of sporting achievements. Year 3 won the football competition, demonstrating excellent teamwork and skill. Year 6 represented the school exceptionally well at the football tournament, and Year 4 returned home with bronze medals from the sportshall athletics competition.

Four Year 6 pupils represented school excellently at the Oracy Debate on Friday and came home with certificates and medals. This is a significant achievement and demonstrates the confidence and communication skills our older children have developed.

Year 6 classes 6M and 6W have completed their Debt Aware sessions this week, with 6B and Year 5 scheduled to participate next week. These sessions provide valuable learning about money management and financial awareness.

Looking ahead, we have several events to look forward to. The Year 1 class assemblies will take place on Tuesday, and we are delighted to host two Rock Steady concerts. The Monday bands concert will be held on Monday 23rd March at 2.15pm with doors opening at 2pm, and the Wednesday bands concert will take place on Wednesday 25th March at 2.15pm with doors opening at 2pm. These concerts showcase the musical talents of our children and are always a highlight of the school calendar.

Finally, please note that the school will finish at 1.30pm on Friday 27th March for the Easter break. I wish you all a lovely weekend.
