Curriculum focus:

Homework: Each Friday, we will set new spellings that will be stuck in their reading diary. Please practice these. We will then test and re-set spellings each Friday. Log ins for TTRS will be in the front of reading diaries so you can access these at home.

Reading at home: Please read at home as often as you can as this has a huge impact on your child's reading progression. We ask that children read a minimum of three times a week. This can be any reading material including their school book, home books, information books, magazines or comics. Please record any reading at home in your child's reading diary so that they get their bookmark stamp. After completing a bookmark they get a small prize and for every third bookmark they complete they can choose a book.



School Uniform: Our school uniform is as follows: Grey/black trousers or skirts. White polo shirt / blouse or shirt. Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan with or without the school logo. Black shoes for boys and girls (no sandals). Light blue and white checked dress, plain coloured socks.
