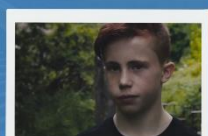

2025/2026 LAIV Nasal Influenza Immunisation (Flu Spray)

All Primary and Secondary school-aged children, including children in Specialist Schools, from Reception Year to Year 11 will be offered the Flu vaccine.

The vaccine is in the form of a nasal spray which is painless and easy to have

Children are more likely to have flu complications and spread the virus, especially to those at higher risk such as the elderly,

The vaccine has been given to millions of children worldwide and has an excellent safety record

The vaccine helps prevent severe illness, hospitalisation, and missed school days
