As well as teaching Y3/4, Miss Cordey has whole school responsibility for PSHE which includes RSE, organising Safety Questionnaires for children and parents as well as School Council.

Our value for the half term is 'Resilience'.


junior parkrun


Whether you choose to run with your family or invite friends, our family fun morning is open to everyone, making sure the kids can join in too.
