

Music - Three-chord pop: Playing in a band

bass line	The lowest-pitched part of a song.
chords	Two or more notes played at the same time.
chord sequence	The order the chords are played in.
melody	A pattern of different pitches; the tune.
singing technique	How to use your voice and body properly so it sounds clear and strong.

A successful band can:

- Play together.
- Watch each other.
- Keep a steady beat.

Roles of the band:

- **Bass:** Plays single notes on beat 1.
- **Chords:** Plays two or more notes at once. Creates the harmony.
- **Singer:** Sings the melody.



Pop song structure

Verse

Tells the story of the song. Words change every verse.

Pre-chorus

Short section to build excitement for the chorus.

A C F F

Chorus

Tells the main message of the song. Repeated, catchy, memorable.
