Maths

In Maths this half term, we will continue to work on our knowledge of formal written methods for addition and subtraction.

We will move on to multiplication and division. It is really important that the children know their times tables. Good times table knowledge helps the children to access lots of different areas in maths. The children all have access to TTRockstars- this can be used at home to practise their tables regularly.
