Maths

In Maths this half term, we will continue to work on our knowledge of formal written methods for multiplication and division.

It is important that the children become secure in their knowledge of 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables. Knowing these quickly and accurately will enable the children to solve even trickier maths problems.

The children will also continue to explore shape and measure during our maths lessons.

We will explore writing our own diaries, as well as writing a description of a famous Roman figure.

The children will continue to build on their punctuation, spelling and grammar knowledge and use this to improve their writing.
