In Maths this half term, we will continue to work on our knowledge of formal written methods for multiplication and division. We will also continue to work on shape, space and measure- including angles.

It is important that the children become secure in their knowledge of 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables. Knowing these quickly and accurately will enable the children to solve even trickier maths problems.

English

In English this half term the children will focus on a writing in a range of different genres including poetry.

The children will continue to build on their punctuation, spelling and grammar knowledge and use this to improve their writing.

Geography –

Science –

Our unit of work this half term is all about light and shadows. We will be learning about:

- Sources of light
- Reflection
- How shadows are formed?
- Creating tables of results
- Making observations

Music – This half term, Year 3 will begin to look at creating music, rhythm and soundscapes.

PE – This half term Year 3 will be taking part in PE on **TUESDAY** afternoons. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit.

PSHE - The children will focus on Citizenship and look at how to be a good member of society

R.E. – The children will be looking at different celebrations and why they are important to people of different faiths and beliefs

Computing – the children will focus on Coding and have the opportunity to use the Micro:Bits as well as look at emailing.

General Reminders

PE - PE will take place every Tuesday afternoon. Please make sure your child comes to school in their full PE kit.

Reading Books - Please make sure children have their reading books and reading journals in school every day.

Homework - Homework will be given to take home every Friday and handed back into school on a Wednesday. It is important that you encourage and support your children with their homework, but please do not do it for them.

Times Tables - It is imperative that children regularly practise their times tables. As part of their homework, children will bring home weekly times tables. We will have a weekly Times Table quiz every Wednesday.
