

Maths

In Maths this half term, we will continue to work on our knowledge of formal written methods for multiplication and division. We will also recap our work on addition and subtraction and look at fractions again. We will also continue to work on shape, space and measure- including angles.

It is important that the children become secure in their knowledge of 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables. Knowing these quickly and accurately will enable the children to solve even trickier maths problems.

English

In English this half term the children will focus on a writing in a range of different genres including writing newspaper reports and non-chronological reports.

The children will continue to build on their punctuation, spelling and grammar knowledge and use this to improve their writing.

Lots of children are keen to get a 'pen trial' this half term. They must try their best with their presentation at all times and use joined up handwriting.

Geography – Year 3 will be exploring the local area. We will be looking for human and physical features in the local area and using maps. We will also look how the local area has changed over time and be comparing the local area with New Delhi.

Science – We will be revisiting all the units of work we have covered this year and investigating grip strength in different ways. Year 3 will be planning investigations, gathering data, analysing data and making conclusions.

Music – This half term the children will look at traditional Indian music.

PE – This half term Year 3 will be taking part in PE on **TUESDAY** afternoons. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit.

PSHE – In PSHE this half term, the children will continue their work on Safety.

R.E. – In RE, the children will look at prayer across different religions.

Computing – In Computing, the children will learn about branching databases and graphs.

General Reminders

PE - PE will take place every Tuesday afternoon. Please make sure your child comes to school in their full PE kit.

Reading Books - Please make sure children have their reading books and reading journals in school every day.

Homework - Homework will be given to take home every Friday and handed back into school on a Wednesday. It is important that you encourage and support your children with their homework, but please do not do it for them.

Times Tables - It is imperative that children regularly practise their times tables. As part of their homework, children will bring home weekly times tables. We will have a weekly Times Table quiz every Wednesday.
