Well done to Year 6 who had the highest attendance this week with 98.8%

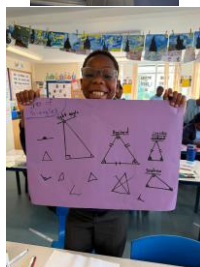
Spotlights on Trips:
