## A Peek At What We Are Learning



### Reading

This half term, we will be reading books by our Author of the Term: Bethan Woollvin.



### Writing

In English, we will be focusing on the book 'Rapunzel' by Bethan Woollvin. We will be using this text to help us write a short narrative retell, in the style of a traditional tale. We will also be continuing to focus on using our phonic knowledge to write.



### Maths

In Maths, we will be working in year groups. Year 1 will be working on Place Value and Addition and Subtraction within 10. Year 2 will be focusing on Place Value and Addition and Subtraction within 100.



### Science

In Science, we will be learning about Living things and their habitats. Our lessons will start by looking at how to tell if somethings is living, dead, or never alive. We will then be moving on to habitats and simple food chains.



### Foundation Studies
