Important Information



P.E will be on Wednesday and a Friday. Please remember to come to school in your full PE kit on both days.

Learning Outside the Classroom (LOTG) lessons will take place on a Thursday. Children will need wellies/walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing. They must be fully covered for LOTG so will need full length trousers and long-sleeved tops/jumpers and coats/waterproof suits.

Reading books will continue to be given out each week, and reading folders need to be in school each day. Please try to read at least 4 times a week, with other opportunities of listening to an adult/sibling taking place too where possible.

Homework will be set on a Friday and is to be returned on the following Wednesday.

The children will need a coat every day for school as the weather is still very cold and wet at times.

A Peek At What We Are Learning



Reading

This half term, we will be reading lots of different non-fiction books. We will also have a focus on 'Jack and the Beanstalk', 'Here We Are' and other Oliver Jeffers books.



Writing

In Literacy we will be continuing with phonics and learning to write words for labels, retelling stories verbally as well as writing them using simple sentences.



Maths

In Maths, we will be practicing our numbers to ten, and comparing numbers to ten. We will learn our number bonds to 10 and we will also have a focus on patterns and pattern making.



Science

In science, we will be learning about animals (excluding humans) and the Earth and Space, which links to our general topic. Some of our science lessons will be carried out as a LOTG lesson.



Foundation Studies

Our topic this half term is 'World Explorers!', so we will be looking at the things and people in our community, changes in the world, celebrations such as Easter and Mothers Day, and also space.
