Important Information

Forest School lessons will take place every week on a Friday afternoon. Children will need wellies/walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing. They must be fully covered for Forest Schools so will need full length trousers and long-sleeved tops/jumpers and coats/waterproof suits.

Reading books/Ditties will be introduced in a few weeks time. Children will initially be reading short words of 2, 3 or 4 letters. Please try to read at least 4 days a week, with someone else reading to you for the other days.

Homework: This year there will be a grid of activities per half term for I task to be completed each week. We still expect reading 4 times a week. Engagement in phonics or spelling.. Children will be given a login of numberbots to reinforce the number skills. The children will need a coat for school as the weather becomes colder and hat/scarf/gloves. Please label them.

Science

In Science, we are looking at seasonal change and sound. We will also be doing some activities linked to these topics in our learning outside the classroom lessons.
