Reading

This half term, we will be reading books by the Author of the Term, Dick King Smith.



Writing

In English, we will be focusing on the book Hermelin. We will be using this text to write and practice our grammar skills. We will be writing simple sentences, using adjectives to describe, using adverbs and pronouns in our writing.



Maths

In Maths, we will be working in year groups. Year 1 will be working on Addition and Subtraction within 10 and Shape. Year 2 will be working on Addition and Subtraction crossing 10s and Shape.



Science

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be identifying, grouping, classifying and researching as part of this unit.
