Important Information

Reading

This half term, we will be reading traditional tales, rhymes and books written by our Author of the half term, Sue Hendra.



Writing

In Literacy, we will be focusing on phonics, writing CVC words, beginning to write sentences and speaking and listening. We will be reading some fantastic books and beginning to write sentences.



Maths

In Maths, we will be working in small groups, working on lots of different skills. We will look at number, shape, space, measure and patterns and focusing on numbers to 8.



Science

In Science, we are looking at animals and materials. We will also be doing some activities linked to these topics in our learning outside the classroom lessons.



Foundation Studies
