### Geography—Why does Population Change?

- Research the population in your area- how has it changed over the years? Make a poster or presentation about this.
- Interview an older person in your family- what can they tell you about how the population of your local area has changed?
- Find out which 5 countries have the highest populations- make a fact file about one of these countries.

### Science— Mixtures & Separation

- Create a mixture of different solids and investigate how to separate them- record and present your findings.
- Try mixing different solids in water- which ones dissolve? Can you separate the water and solid again? Present your findings.

### Art & Design—Sculpture: Interactive Installation

- Design and build an interactive installation using materials of your choice- bring it in to school or take photos to show us.

### French—La Phonétique

- Create a poster explaining how to pronounce a French word, of your choice, correctly.
- Teach someone at home how to have a mini conversation in French; make sure they pronounce everything accurately.

### Computing—Online Safety

- Create a leaflet teaching younger children about the importance of online safety.
- Create a list of 'top tips' for keeping yourself safe online that we could display around school.
