Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you are all keeping safe and well during this incredibly warm weather! We are pleased that we have been able to keep school open (with some reasonable adjustments), and we thank you all for your support.

Last week Ash class presented their assembly to Williamson House and their family members. The children did a brilliant job, sharing their learning over the last term across the curriculum. It was wonderful to see how much they have progressed this year and they are certainly ready to move to KS2 in September. Well done to everyone in Ash!

As part of Sports week, Ash class enjoyed taking part in a circus skills session. We learnt how to balance different objects such as peacock feathers and spinning cups.

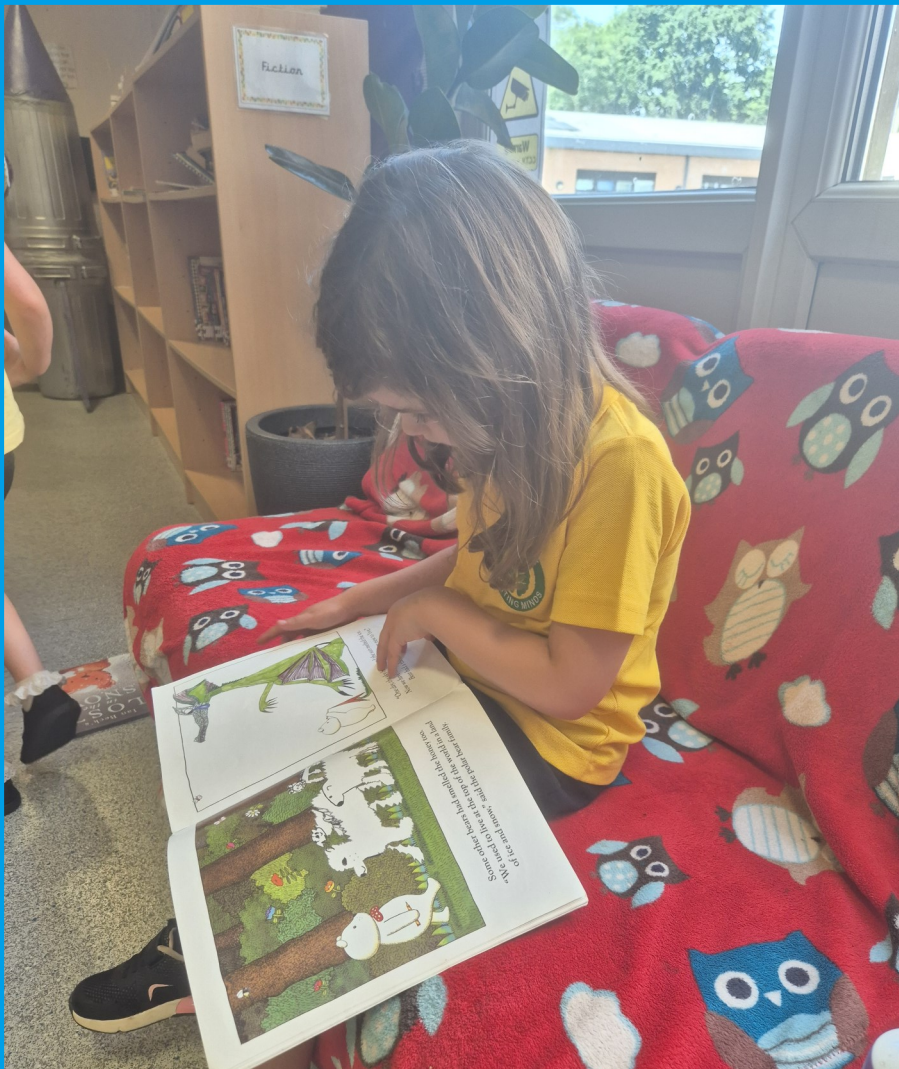




This week, Elm have managed so well in the heat.

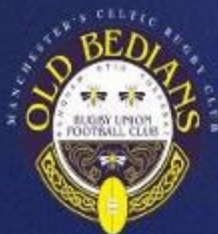
