
# Year 4's Newsletter


This half term the children will be focusing on a text called 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne in their writing lessons.





In Maths, we will be focusing on Place Value this term.

Throughout the year there will be a big focus on Times Tables. There will be a times tables test each Friday.

In Geography we will be learning about a contrasting locality. We will be comparing Port Sunlight to our local area Newton-le-Willows.

#### Reading

Group guided reading sessions will be daily. An adult will read with your child once a week and it will be recorded in their reading record. Children can change their book independently when they have completed it.
