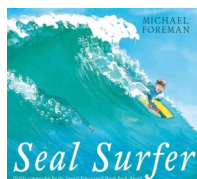
We will always do our best to make ourselves available should you need to contact us at any point throughout the school year. Please call the office to arrange an appointment if there is a matter you would like discuss.

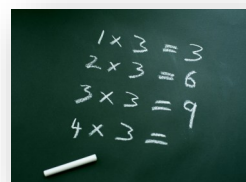
English

In English, we will be using the book 'Seal Surfer' by Michael Foreman and we will be looking at letter writing based on this book.



Mathematics

We will be focusing on Place Value this term. Throughout this whole year there will be a big focus on Times Tables. There will be a times tables test each Friday. The first will be next week and it will be testing the children's understanding of the 2 times tables, up to 12×2 . More information about future times tables tests will follow.



Reading

Group Guided Reading sessions will be daily and your child will be heard reading each week. Please ensure their reading record is in school each day. In Year 3, all children will bring a school banded book home each day, their reading must be recorded in the reading journal and children can change their book independently when they have completed it.

This half term our RE lessons will focus on Harvest.



P.E. lessons are on Thursdays. Please ensure that your child comes to school in a P.E. kit on Thursdays.

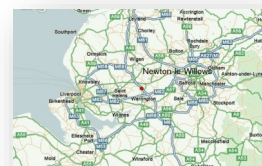
Science
