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Dear Parent/Guardian,

At St Peter's we're always looking for ways to extend our pupils' learning. That's why we are now using CENTURY – a ground-breaking online learning platform.

What is CENTURY?

CENTURY is an online learning tool for pupils. It combines artificial intelligence with the latest research in learning science and neuroscience.

The platform identifies every pupil's strengths, gaps in knowledge and misconceptions. Pupils can log in and complete work that has been suggested for them by the advanced recommendation engine, or work which has been set by teachers.

It allows pupils to take control of their own learning and for teachers to get real-time data on progress, allowing them to quickly identify which pupils need support or additional challenge.

What does this mean for my child's learning?

Teachers will initially use the platform for homework, but also have the capacity to use it as a home learning tool should class isolation become necessary. They will also be using it for booster and catch-up groups where appropriate.

Accessing CENTURY

Pupils are able to access CENTURY anytime and anywhere. It is available to them in school and also at home. All they need to do is visit the <u>CENTURY website</u> and enter their unique login details. Their login details where shared with the children today and can be found in their reading record. The children have practiced logging in at school and were shown where their homework nuggets could be found. Homework can be find under "My Assignments" and there will usually be 2 or 3 nuggets. The nuggets will be added each Friday to be completed by the following Thursday. I spoke with the children about also accessing their own personalised learning pathway each week as well. The more that your child access their learning pathway, the more the pathway will become personalised to them.

The platform can be accessed from tablets and laptops on up-to-date versions of most common browsers. The best browsers are Chrome on PCs and Android devices and Safari on iPads. It is not currently optimised for use on mobile phones.
