P.E. lessons are on Thursdays. Please ensure that your child comes to school


in a P.E. kit every Thursday. After school Multi Sport club takes place on a Friday. Children should bring their PE kit in a bag and they will change at the end of the school day.

Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on Addition and Subtraction including



- a three-digit number and tens
- a three-digit number and hundreds
- add and subtract numbers with up to three digits
- using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction
- estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers
- solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

This half term we will be learning Physics—"What can magnets do?" with Mrs Colley.
