English

This half term, the children will read 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy. They will write a traditional tale focusing on describing settings, characters and an alternative ending. They will integrate dialogue (using speech punctuation) to convey the character and advance the action.

Mathematics

Autumn 2

We will be beginning to look at mental and formal written methods for adding and subtracting large numbers. After that, we will be looking at multiplication and division (particularly looking for multiples, factors, square, cube and prime numbers).



Science

This half term we will be looking at 'Space and the Planets'. We will look at evidence for and against a spherical Earth, and continue by looking at how our Solar System is made up and how night and day occurs simultaneously at different parts on our globe.

The children will identify the nativity stories of Matthew and Luke and consider the purpose of the Gospel writers.
