## Welcome to Summer Term 1

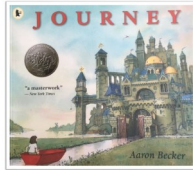

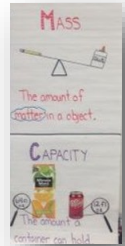
### English

This half term we will focus on the way God calls us.

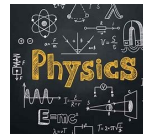


#### P.E.
