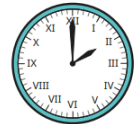
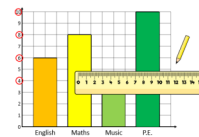
### English

Our RE focus this half term we be about the rules we should follow.

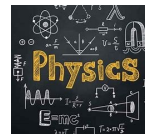
#### P.E.
