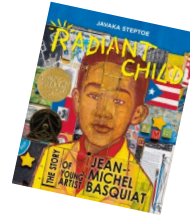

English

Mathematics

In our work on decimals, we will be adding and subtracting decimals and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

Science

This half term, we will learn about famous scientists.

Computing
