PVGP (place value for grammar and punctuation)

We're starting this half term with a focus on securing the fundamentals of writing sentences by teaching a 4 week unit on the 'Place Value of Grammar and Punctuation'. The purpose of this is to ensure that children are fully secure in understanding how sentences are constructed and punctuated and will then be able to apply this knowledge to their written work.

We will follow this up with some nonchronological report writing for pupils to apply their learning.
