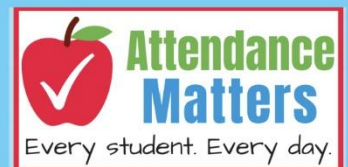


ATTENDANCE WINNERS:

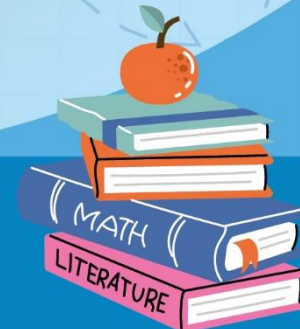
